



VIP – FOR GRADUATES (Viadrina International Program - for Graduates) Fellowships for research stays of international doctoral researchers at the European University Viadrina

The Viadrina International Program – for Graduates (VIP) enables international doctoral researchers to apply for a research stay of up to three months at the European University Viadrina. The Commission for the Appropriation of Funds within the Field of Research and Graduate Education of the European University Viadrina holds the responsibility for all assessments during the application process.

TARGET GROUP

International doctoral researchers from international universities in any of the disciplines represented at the European University Viadrina are eligible to apply. Prospective applicants can only receive a fellowship if they are not receiving other funding for the same purpose and for the same period.

TYPE OF FUNDING

In 2024, grants for research stays at the European University Viadrina can be given for up to 3 months in form of a travel and accommodation allowance. The amount of the funding depends on the country of origin and the period of stay. The actual duration of the research stay may exceed the maximum funding period. Funding can be granted by no earlier than April 2024. Approved research stays can be granted until June 30th, 2024 at the latest. The minimum stay is 1 month.

In addition to receiving funding by the Viadrina International Program – for Graduates (VIP), it might also be possible to apply for grants for children, foster children and children living in the household at the family representative of the European University

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- **Application form**
- Curriculum Vitae, with publications list if applicable
- Letter of motivation (max. 3 pages): Please state your motivation for the research stay at the European University Viadrina. In addition to presenting the academic activities you intend to do during your stay. Please also describe to what extent the fellowship will promote your research project and improves international networking
- Proof of completed university degree
- Proof of doctorate study at the home university
- Letter of invitation by a professor of the European University Viadrina (See: HINWEISE FÜR DAS EINLADUNGSSCHREIBEN)
- **Written assessment by a supervisor of the home university**
- Summary of the PhD project, incl. table of contents and working plan schedule (max. 5 pages)
- Detailed time schedule of the research stay at the European University Viadrina
