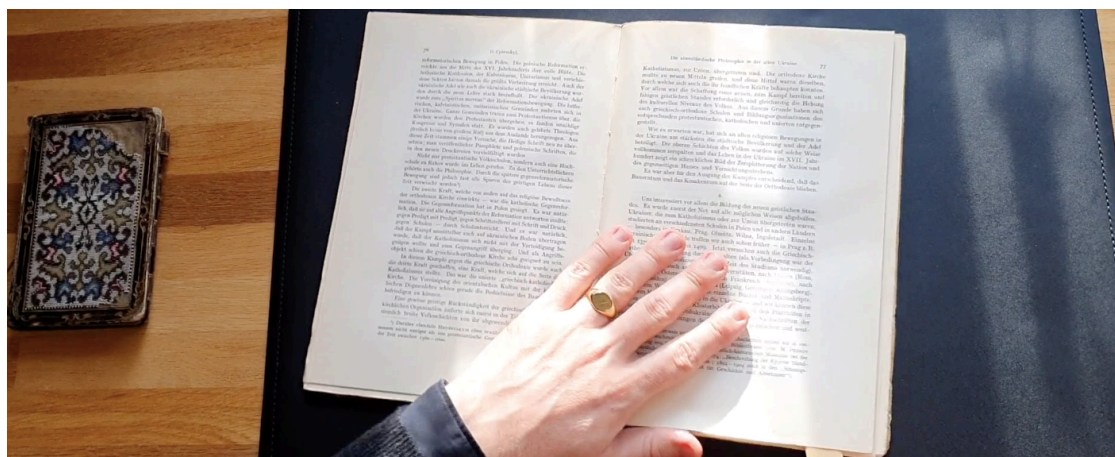
### Upcoming Online Event

### New videoblog: “Історії істориків. Борис Крупницький”

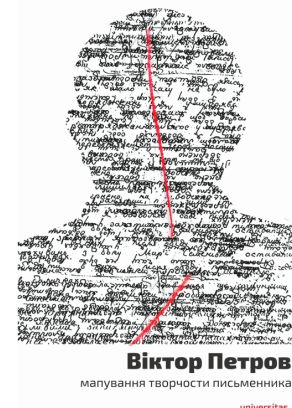
